This report summarized that conditions were worse than in previous years. WSP will submit a proposal regarding next steps to take in remediating the problems that were observed.

B-2 Mr. Schuhmann related that WSP still intends to submit a proposal for evaluating the existing Solid Waste Facility site. It is the stated intent of the Board to select a consultant at the August Board meeting.

B-3 Peytona Fire District has made a request that the 109 Taxing District assist them with the removal and disposal of the debris from demolition work at the fire station. Gould shared a copy of the District's policy titled "PARTICIPATON IN PUBLIC EVENTS WHICH WILL RESULT IN 109 SERVICES WILL BE OFFERED FREE OF CHARGE". Chairman Newton is authorized to continue discussions with the Peytona Fire District within these guidelines.
